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	Subject	Details
1	Islamic greeting	This lesson discusses the beauty and greatness of the Islamic greeting "Assalamu Alaikum." The students will learn why this greeting is the best
2	Hajj/Eid ul Adha	This lesson will cover the last pillar of Islam and will coincide with the time of Hajj. We will also learn about the special holiday of Eid following it.
3	Saying bismillah	The students will learn about an important Islamic manner - to say bismillah before doing anything
4	Allah	Who is Allah, what did He create? Students will learn that everything in the world is created by Allah.
5	Allah's oneness	Students will learn about tauheed and how He always existed. There is no one like Him.
6	Islam - our faith	Basic idea about Islam, and why we follow it.
7	Allah is watching	How Allah is always watching us so we should try our best to be good all the time.
8	Angels/Shaitan	Who are angels, their duties? Why is Shaitan our enemy and what does he do?
9	Adam(A)	This lesson is an introduction to the first Prophet, Adam (A). A short account of his life is covered.
10	5 Pillars of Islam	Now that students have learned a few things about Islam, they will be introduced to the 5 Pillars of Islam
11	Shahada	This lesson covers the basics of the first pillar of Islam.
12	Salah	This lesson will cover the basics of Salah. Etiquettes and virtues of prayer. We will also learn about Qibla, adhaan, prayer timings and how to be in a masjid.
13	Wudu/Purity	This will be an ongoing process. Students will learn the steps and importance of purity.
14	Fasting	This lesson covers the basics of the third pillar of Islam.
15	Zakah/sharing	This pillar covers the basics of the fourth pillar and how important it is to share with the poor and needy.
16	Nuh(A)	This lesson is an introduction to Nuh (A). A short account of how he was saved from the flood.
17	Ibrahim(A)	This lesson is an introduction to Ibrahim (A). He never listened to Shaitan. A short account of his life is covered
18	Musa(A)	This lesson is an introduction to Musa (A). A short account of his life is covered.
19	Isa(A)	This lesson is an introduction to Isa (A). A short account of his life and his mother is covered.
20	Prophet Muhammad(s)	Students will learn about Muhammad (S). Who he was, why we respect him, and what he did for his ummah will be covered.
21	How Prophet Muhammad(s) treated others	During his entire life, the Prophet (S) treated people with dignity, truthfulness, compassion, and love. This lesson provides some of the details.
22	Makkah & Madinah	Two great places--importance of each of the Cities.
23	Quran	The students will learn about the Qur'an--a book of guidance for all Muslims
24	Sunnah/Hadith	This lesson provides an introduction to the Sunnah and Hadith. The students will know why they are important and why we should follow them.
25	Good manners/character	What are the good manners in Islam? Why should we show good manners? The students will learn about importance of good manners.
26	Honest/Truthfulness	The importance of always being truthful and trustworthy will be discussed.
27	Kindness/Sharing	Why should we share and why should we show kindness? A great moral building lesson for early beginners.
28	Controlling anger	Talking about good character, this lesson will teach another important character trait is to control one's anger.
29	Younus(A)	This lesson is an introduction to Younus (A). Emphasis on his du'a.

30	Sulaiman(A)	We will learn about Sulaiman(A)'s special powers that Allah gave him and how these powers were used for doing good deeds.
31	Earth day	Students will learn the importance of taking care our planet,and community. We will also learn about Recycling and how not to waste the resources Allah has provided us with.
32	Cleanliness	We cannot be a good Muslim unless we know the importance of cleanliness in our daily lives. The lesson shows the meaning of purity.
33	Yousuf(A)	This lesson is an introduction to Yusuf (A). His life with his father and brothers. Lessons of Patience.
34	Parents	We will learn that we need to love, respect obey our parents.
35	Ramadan/Eid	Special month of Ramadaan will be covered and the special holiday of Eid followig it.
36	Muslims from different parts of the world	Students will learn about Muslims from all over the world. Unity in diversity makes the Muslims a great nation.
